

IAABO RULES PRACTICE QUIZ 2010 – 2011 (page 1)

1.) B-1 in a marked lane space steps into the lane followed by A-2 stepping in prior to the ball hitting the ring, backboard or the free throw ending. A-2 then commits basket interference.

Official awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

2.) Following a time-out, A-1, who is to attempt a one-and-one, is not in the semi-circle as the official is ready to administer the free throw.

Official assesses A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

3.) B-1 is charged with his/her fifth foul and A-1 is awarded two free throws. Prior to B-1 being replaced, A-6 reports to enter the game.

Official denies A-6 from entering the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

4.) Prior to the game, a technical foul is charged to team A. While the ball is at the disposal of B-1 for the first attempt, a double personal foul is called. Following the free throws for the technical fouls, official resumes play with a jump ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO

5.) A-1 and B-1 jump at the center circle to start the game. A-1 taps the ball and B-1 catches the ball before the jump ball ends.

Official awards the ball to team A and sets the arrow in the direction of A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

6.) B-1 commits his/her fifth foul, but the scorer fails to notify the officials. Later in the quarter, B-1 is fouled and awarded two free throws. Following the first free throw, which was successful, the scorer notifies the referee that B-1 is playing with five fouls.

The referee rules that Rule 2.10 applies, cancels the first free throw and has B-1's substitute attempt the two free throws. Is the referee correct? YES or NO

7.) A-1 and B-1 get into a confrontation which is handled by the officials without penalty. A-6 and A-7 leave the bench and come on the floor.

Official charges one team foul to team A, one indirect technical foul to the coach, and awards team B two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

8.) During an alternating possession throw-in, A-1, places the ball through the plane of the boundary line. B-1 grabs the ball and a held ball is ruled.

Official awards the ball to team B ruling that the ball was touched after the time the alternating possession procedure ended. Is the official correct? YES or NO

9.) A-1, in the frontcourt, deflects a throw-in into the backcourt. A-2 is the first to touch it.

Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

10.) A -1 and B-1 are the jumpers to start the game. A-1 taps the ball and B-1 catches it before the jump ball ends.

Official rules this a violation, awards the ball to team A and sets the arrow toward team B's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) A-1 is fouled and injured on the play. A-6 replaces A-1. Prior to A-6 entering the semi-circle to attempt the free throws awarded to A-1, A-7 reports to replace A-6.

The official beckons A-7 into the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) A-1 is erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds instead of the one and one. A-1's inbound pass goes to A-2, who is tied up by B-2 and a held ball is ruled. The possession arrow favors team A. The error is now recognized.

Official awards A-1 the one and one with no players occupying the marked lane spaces and uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

13.) A-1 is fouled as the first half ends. Team A is in the bonus but the scorer fails to notify the official. The second half starts with team A making the throw-in and scores. The error is now recognized.

Official awards A-1 the one and one with players occupying the marked lane spaces and plays off the made or miss. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) A-1 ends his dribble. A-1 passes to a teammate, but the ball strikes an official and rebounds back to A-1. When A-1 touches the ball

the official rules this an illegal dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) A-1, an airborne shooter, was fouled in the act of shooting. Prior to returning to the floor, A-1 charges B-2 who has obtained a legal guarding position. Ball enters basket.

Official charges A-1 with a player control foul, disallows the basket, and awards A-1 two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) A-1 is awarded one free throw. While the ball is in flight, A-2 and B-2 commit a double personal foul followed by A-1 committing a free throw violation. Possession arrow favors team A.

The official awards the ball to team B because of the violation by team A instead of at the point of interruption. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) A-1's field goal attempt is on the ring when B-1 intentionally slaps the backboard causing it to vibrate.

Official rules this basket interference and assesses B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

IAABO RULES PRACTICE QUIZ 2010 – 2011 (page 3)

18.) A-1, from behind the 3 point line, throws the ball toward his/her basket for a catch and dunk. The ball is on its downward flight outside the cylinder above the ring level and in the judgment of the official has a chance of entering the basket when A-2 catches the ball and dunks it.

The official rules this is goaltending and disallows the basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) While A-1 has the ball for a throw-in, A-2 commits a common foul against B-2. Team B is in the bonus.

Official awards B-2 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) A-1 notices that he/she is bleeding from a scratch on the arm. A-1 requests a timeout which is granted. A-1's bleeding is stopped during the timeout. Following the timeout, A-1 comes back on the floor ready to play.

Official denies A-1 from entering the game until the next opportunity to substitute. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) A-1, while holding the ball and closely guarded in the frontcourt has the ball slip from his/her grasp with the officials count at two. A-1 recovers the ball.

Official starts a new 5 second count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) B-1 fouls A-1 while in the act of shooting. Ball enters basket. It is B-1's fifth foul. B-6 reports and is beckoned into the game. B-6 joins his/her teammates, who are huddling with their coach.

Official instructs team B to break the huddle but the coach continues to huddle. Official administers the free throw to A-1. The try is successful. Following the free throw, and team B still huddling, the official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) Team A is behind by three points when A-1, in front of the team B bench, attempts a 3-point try at the horn. B-6 comes off the bench and blocks the ball just after A-1 releases the ball.

Official charges team B with a flagrant technical foul and awards team A three free throws. Is the official correct? YES OR NO

24.) Player A-1 sets a rear screen on stationary B-2, closer than one normal step. As B-2 turns and prior to placing a foot to the floor, contacts A-1.

Official rules this an illegal screen. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) During a foul reporting sequence, the official is ready to administer the first of two free throws to A-1 but the first two marked lane spaces above the neutral zone marks are not occupied. Official directs team B to occupy the spaces. Team B players continue to delay.

Official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES

26.) B-1 in a marked lane space steps into the lane followed by A-2 stepping in prior to the ball hitting the ring, backboard or the free throw ending. A-2 then commits basket interference.

Official awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) A-1 and B-1 get into a confrontation which is handled by the officials without penalty. A-6 and A-7 leave the bench and come on the floor.

Official charges one team foul to team A, one indirect technical foul to the coach, and awards team B two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) A-1 is fouled and injured on the play. A-6 replaces A-1. Prior to A-6 entering the semi-circle to attempt the free throws awarded to A-1, A-7 reports to replace A-6.

The official beckons A-7 into the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) Following a field goal by team A, B-1 has the ball for the throw-in. B-1 runs and jumps through the plane of the boundary line. B-1 releases the ball when he/she is three feet beyond the boundary line and over the court.

Official rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) A-1, while in the act of shooting and prior to releasing the ball, is fouled after time expires. A-1 continues the motion and scores.

Official disallows the basket but penalizes the foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

31.) While A-1 is holding the ball to attempt a free throw, A-2 commits a common foul.

Official rules it a team control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

32.) At the end of regulation play with the score tied, team A requests a 60-second timeout. Following the timeout, team A requests a 30-second timeout.

Official grants the request. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) After the signal sounded indicating time had expired in the first half, A-1 removes his/her jersey within the visual confines of the playing area. YES or NO

Official charges A-1 with a technical foul and an indirect technical foul to the coach. Is the official correct?

34.) While A-1 is dribbling, A-2 fouls B-2 and B-3 fouls A-3 simultaneously. Both teams are in the bonus.

Official awards both teams a one and one and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) A-1 is awarded one free throw. After the successful free throw the lead official recognizes that one player from each team is occupying the first marked lane spaces.

After a brief discussion, officials rule this a double free throw violation and cancel the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

36.) While A-1 is attempting his/her first of two free throws, A-6 reports to the table to substitute for A-5. Following the first free throw, the scorer sounds the horn and the official beckons A-6 into the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

37.) A-1 is awarded one free throw. As A-1's free throw is in flight, B-1 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows. A-1's try is unsuccessful.

Official rules B-1's action is a violation and awards team A the ball out of bounds nearest the spot of the violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) Official calls a 3 second violation during A-1's interrupted dribble.

Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) A-1's try is in flight which the trail official signals as a 3-point try, as the signal sounds indicating time has expired in the fourth quarter. Ball enters basket tying the score. Coach of team B confers with the

officials that A-1's try was a 2-point try. Officials rule the coach is incorrect. Team B has used all of its 60-second timeouts but has one 30-second timeout remaining. YES or NO

Officials charge team B with an excessive timeout and assesses a technical foul. Is the official correct?

40.) Team A submits its squad list and starting line-up 10 minutes before the game. Three minutes before the game the coach of team A adds two names to the squad list and is assessed a technical foul. As the official is about to hand the ball to B-1 to attempt the first free throw, the scorer notifies the official that A-6 replaced A-5, the designated starter.

Official charges team A with another technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

41.) During an alternating possession procedure, A-1, the thrower-in, places the ball through the boundary line. B-1 grabs the ball and a held ball is called.

Official awards the ball to team B, stating that when the ball was touched the arrow changes. Is the official correct? YES or NO

42.) While the ball is at the disposal of A-1 for a throw-in, A-2 commits a common foul on B-2. This is team A's seventh foul of the half.

Official awards B-2 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO

43.) A-1, while airborne, taps the ball to the floor. A-1, returns to the floor, catches the ball and begins a dribble.

The official rules this a double dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

44.) A-1 ends his/her dribble and jumps into the air to attempt a shot. While in the air, A-1 fumbles the ball, recovers and returns to the floor. A-1 starts another dribble.

Official rules this a double dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

45.) A-1 from the backcourt throws a pass to A-2, who is in the frontcourt. The ball is overthrown and hits the backboard and rebounds into the backcourt. A-1 is the first to touch the ball.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

46.) Following a time-out, free thrower A-1 delays by not entering the semi-circle.

Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

47.) Team A is awarded the ball to start the second half. Team A commits a throw-in violation. Official instructs the scorer to turn the possession arrow toward team B's basket and awards team B the ball. Team B commits a throw-in violation.

Official awards the ball to team A and instructs the scorer to turn the possession arrow toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

48.) B-1 is bleeding. The official stops the game and directs B-1 to the bench. As B-1 is being attended by the trainer, Team A requests and is granted a time-out. Following the time-out, B-1 is ready to resume play and enters the court.

The official allows B-1 to continue to play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

49.) A-1, prior to dribbling, passes the ball to A-2. A-2 does not see the pass. A-1 runs across the court and recovers the ball with both hands after the ball has hit the floor. A-1 then begins a dribble.

The official rules this an illegal dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

50.) A-1, while straddling the division line, fumbles the ball. The ball then lands in the frontcourt. A-1 recovers the ball while still straddling the line.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
