

IAABO RULE# 2 PRACTICE QUIZ 2010 – 2011 (page 1)

1.) The time allowed for an interval of time to replace a disqualified or injured player, or a player directed to leave the game, is 30 seconds. Is this correct? YES or NO

2.) B-1 is directed to the bench because of blood on his/her uniform. The official directs the timer to start the 20-second clock to replace B-1. Is the official correct? YES or NO

3.) A-1 is fouled but the official errs and allows A-2 to attempt the free throws. A-2's first try is successful. As the official bounces the ball to A-2, B-1 steps into the lane and bats the ball away.

Official assesses B-1 with a technical foul. B-1 now informs the official that A-2 was not the player who was fouled. YES or NO

Official now recognizes the error, cancels the free throw, and rules the technical foul will stand. Official has A-1 attempt his/her free throws, then administer the free throws for the technical foul and awards team A the ball out of bounds at the division line opposite the table. Is the official correct?

4.) A-1 is fouled while in the act of shooting. The try is successful and A-1 is awarded one free throw. Prior to the free throw team B is granted a 30-second time-out. Following the time-out, the official erroneously awards team A the ball out of bounds. A-2 is fouled after catching the throw-in. Team A is not in the bonus. The error is now recognized.

Official awards A-1 his/her free throw with players occupying the marked lane spaces and resumes play from the successful or unsuccessful free throw attempt. Is the official correct? YES or NO

5.) A-1 is fouled and erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds. Following the throw-in, B-1 intercepts the pass, but fumbles the ball back to A-2. The error is now recognized.

Official awards A-1 his/her one-and-one with no players occupying the marked lane spaces and resumes play from the point of interruption. Is the official correct? YES or NO

6.) The official erroneously states one and one instead of two shots. A-1 misses the first free throw, which is rebounded by B-1. As B-1 is dribbling up court, B-3 is charged with a common foul against A-3. Team A is in the bonus. The error is now recognized.

The official awards A-1 his/her second free throw with the lane cleared, then awards A-3 a one and one and plays off the make or miss. Is the official correct? YES or NO

7.) Coach of team A is charged with a direct technical foul. Later in the game an indirect technical foul is assessed to the coach. YES or NO

Official ejects the coach for receiving his/her second technical foul. Is the official correct?

8.) A-2 commits his/her fifth foul and is directed to the bench.

After notifying the coach, the official instructs the timer to start the 20 second clock and sound a warning horn five seconds before time expires to replace A-1. Is the official correct? YES or NO

9.) A-1 is fouled and erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds. Following the throw-in, B-1 intercepts a pass, but fumbles the ball back to A-2. The error is now recognized.

The official awards A-1 his/her one and one with no players occupying the marked lane spaces and resumes play at the point of interruption. Is the official correct?

10.) A-1 is erroneously awarded a one and one. After the successful free throws, B-1 completes throw-in by passing to B-2, who commits a traveling violation. Prior to the ball becoming live the error is recognized.

Official rules the time frame to correct has expired. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) Substitute B-6 enters the court while the ball is in control of Team A and while the ball is live and the clock is running. The officials are unaware that Team B has 6 players in the game. B-6 returns to the bench after which Team A commits a violation. The scorer now informs the officials that Team B had 6 players on the court.

The referee rules no technical foul can be charged. Is the referee correct? YES or NO

12.) During the pregame warm-up, team member No. 24 dunks the ball. The official informs the coach that No. 24 was assessed with a technical foul and an indirect is charged to the coach. The officials, however, start the game with a jump ball. After several baskets, the coach of team B questions the officials about not receiving the two free throws for the technical foul and the ball.

After a brief discussion, the officials rule team B should be awarded two free throws and the ball and should resume play with a throw-in at the division line. Were the officials correct? YES or NO

13.) With 1 second remaining in the game, team B is leading 88 to 86. B-1 fouls A-1. Official erroneously states a one and one instead of two. A-1's first try is unsuccessful and all players attempt to rebound the miss. A-2 taps ball before the horn sounds and ball enters the basket. The error is now recognized.

Official counts the basket and awards A-1 his/her merited free throw and rules the make or miss will determine if an overtime will be played. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) A-1 is knocked to the floor and hits his/her head. The official determines that A-1 has been rendered unconscious during the first quarter. At halftime, the coach informs the referee that the appropriate health care professional has ruled that A-1 has recovered and will start the third quarter.

The referee allows A-1 to return. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) The administering official erroneously states two free throws instead of a one and one. A-1 misses the first and makes the second. B-1 inbounds the ball to B-2, who is advancing the ball up court when the scorer recognizes the error. The timer sounds the horn to alert the official.

Official stops the game to confer with the scorer. Does the scorer have the authority to sound the horn at this time? YES or NO

16.) A-1 is fouled. The scorer informs the official that it is the 10th foul on team B. The first free throw is unsuccessful. The second free throw is successful. When B-1 has the ball for the throw-in, the scorer informs the official that team B has only committed nine team fouls.

Official cancels the last free throw and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) A-1 is fouled in the act of shooting a 3-point try. The try is unsuccessful. Erroneously the official states 2 instead of 3 free throws. A-1 makes the first and misses the second. B-2 rebounds and is fouled by A-5. Team B is in the bonus. Following the second free throw which is successful, the official recognizes the error.

Official informs the coach that the error cannot be corrected because the statute of limitations has expired. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) A-1 is fouled and awarded a one and one. A-1 misses the first attempt. B-1 gets the rebound and is then fouled by A-2. The scorer now notifies the official that team A was not in the bonus.

The official rules the correct procedure is to cancel the foul on A-2 and play from the point of interruption. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-1 is directed to leave the game because of wearing illegal apparel. Official notifies the coach and instructs the timer to start the 20 second clock. After the warning horn sounds and before A-5's substitute reports, B-6 and B-7 report to enter the game.

Official rules B-6 and B-7 may not enter because they reported after the warning horn. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) Team A is granted an excessive time-out but the scorer fails to notify the official. During the throw-in the scorer sounds the horn and informs the official that team A's time-out was an excessive time-out.

Official charges team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) The official's jurisdiction is terminated and the final score approved when all officials leave the visual confines of the playing area.

Is this correct? YES or NO

22.) Team A's coach is charged with one indirect technical foul and one direct technical foul. Official ejects the coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) A-1 is directed to leave the game because of wearing illegal apparel. Official notifies the coach and instructs the timer to start the 20 second clock. After the warning horn sounds and before A-5's substitute reports, B-6 and B-7 report to enter the game.

Official rules B-6 and B-7 may not enter because they reported after the warning horn. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) A-1's pass is deflected out of bounds by B-1. The official is ready to administer the throw-in but team A is huddling and no player is available for the throw-in.

25.) Official places the ball on the floor and starts the 5 second count. Is the official correct? YES Or NO
25.) Official erroneously awards A-2 a one and one. A-2 makes both free throws. B-1 passes to B-2 who scores. While the ball is at the disposal of team A, the error is recognized. Official rules the time frame to correct has expired. Is the official correct? YES OR NO
