

IAABO RULE# 6 PRACTICE QUIZ 2010 – 2011 (page 1)

1.) As the official bounces the ball to free thrower A-1 and before A-1 catches the ball, the ball is dead.

Is this correct? YES or NO

2.) On the jump ball to start the game, jumper A-1 catches the ball prior to the jump ball ending.

Official rules this a violation, awards team B the ball and sets the arrow toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

3.) While A-1's try is in flight, a double personal foul is charged. Ball enters basket. Possession arrow favors team A.

Official charges the foul, counts the goal, awards team B the ball and rules team B may move along the end line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

4.) Before A-1's free throw is released, A-2 fouls B-2 then A-3 steps into the lane.

Official rules team A committed both a foul and a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

5.) As the official bounces the ball to A-1 for a throw-in and prior to A-1 catching the ball, B-2 fouls A-2.

Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

6.) Team A is behind by two points with six-tenths of a second remaining in the game and has the ball for a throw-in at the division line. A-1's throw-in hits the backboard and the official inadvertently sounds the whistle. Possession arrow favors team B. Officials confer and award the ball back to team A at the spot of the throw-in. Were the officials correct? YES or NO

7.) A-1 is between B-1 and B-2 on the restraining circle prior to the jump ball. As the

official is ready to make the toss, A-1 backs straight off the circle. B-1 moves over next to B-2. Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

8.) While the ball is at the disposal of A-1 during an alternating possession procedure, A-1 commits a throw-in violation.

Official awards the ball to team B and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow toward team B's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

9.) Following a field goal and prior to the ball being at the disposal of team A, A-1 fouls B-1.

Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

10.) During an alternating possession procedure throw-in, A-1 releases the ball. Before the ball is touched inbounds, B-2 fouls A-2. Team A is not in the bonus.

Official awards the ball back to team A and rules this is still an alternating possession procedure throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) Following a field goal and before the ball is at the disposal of the team entitled to the throw-in, the ball is dead. Is this correct? YES or NO

12.) With team A winning 54–53, A–1 taps the ball toward team B's basket. The horn sounds ending the fourth quarter, the ball enters the basket.

Official counts the goal. Is the official correct? YES or NO

13.) A–1 and B–1 are jumping to start the game. As the official tosses the ball, B–1 leaves his/her jumping position before the ball is tapped but stays within the center restraining circle. After the ball hits the floor B–1 catches it.

Official rules this a violation for leaving his/her jumping position before the ball is tapped. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) During a Team A alternating possession throw-in, A-1's throw-in pass is kicked by B-1. The official rules a kicking violation and further rules that the alternating possession throw-in has not ended.

The official instructs the scorer to leave the arrow for Team A, then awards Team A a throw-in at the original alternating possession throw-in spot. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) Jumper A-1 catches the ball after the ball has been tapped, but before the jump ball has ended.

Official rules this a violation, awards team B the ball and sets the arrow toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) After the referee tosses the ball for a jump ball and before the ball is tapped, A–2 moves into an unoccupied space. Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) A–1 has the ball out of bounds for an alternating possession throw-in when B–2 fouls A–2 prior to the bonus.

Official awards the ball back to team A and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow when the ball is touched inbounds. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) While A-1's try is in flight the official inadvertently sounds the whistle. The try is unsuccessful. Official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) During an alternating possession procedure throw-in, thrower-in A–1 breaks the plane of the boundary line with the ball. B–1 grasps the ball and neither player can get the ball from the other.

Official rules a jump ball and gives the ball back to team A for an alternating possession throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) As the official is ready to toss the ball for a jump ball, A–2 backs straight off the circle.

Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) During an alternating possession throw-in by team A, A-1's throw-in is touched by B-1 who has a foot on the boundary line. The official rules it a violation on team B and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow toward team B's basket and awards team A the ball nearest the spot where B-1 touched the ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) Team A is awarded the ball for an alternating possession throw-in. Prior to the alternating possession procedure ending, team A commits a throw-in violation.

Official rules team A loses the ball plus the arrow. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) As the official is ready to toss the ball for a jump ball, but before the ball leaves his/her hands, A-2 moves onto the circle.

Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) During an alternating possession throw-in by team A, A-1's throw-in is caught by both A-3 and B-3 causing a held ball. Official rules the possession arrow be turned and awards the ball to team B. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) Prior to the game a technical foul is charged to team A. While the ball is at the disposal of B-1 for the first attempt, a double personal foul ruling is made. Following the free throws for the technical foul the official resumes play with a jump ball with the two involved players. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) While A-1's try is in flight, B-1 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows. The try is successful.

Official rules this a violation on B-1 and awards team A the ball out of bounds nearest the spot of the violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw, B-1 fouls A-2 along the line. Official blows the whistle. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official cancels the free throw, charges the foul and re-administers the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) With three-tenths of a second remaining in the game, A-1's throw-in is caught by A-2, who is fouled as he/she throws the ball toward his/her basket. The foul occurs before the signal sounds indicating time has expired. Team A is in the bonus. The official awards A-1 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) A-1 and B-1 jump to start the game. A-1 touches the ball and B-1 catches it before the jump ball has ended. Official awards the ball to team A and sets the arrows toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) A-1 is to attempt the first of a one and one. As the ball is being bounced from the lead official to A-1 and prior to A-1 catching the ball, B-1 fouls A-2. Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

31.) One official calls a block and the other official calls a foul on the airborne shooter. Ball enters basket.

Official rules a double personal foul, counts the basket and uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct?
