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1.) B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line and slaps the ball out of thrower-in A-1's hands.

Official charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

2.) During A-1's throw-in, A-2, airborne from the frontcourt, catches the pass and passes to A-3, who is also airborne from the frontcourt. A-3 lands in the backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

3.) B-1 intentionally extends his/her leg to block the pass. The ball hits B-1 above the knee.

Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

4.) During a throw-in, in team A's frontcourt, A-1's throw-in is deflected into the backcourt by A-2. A-2 is the first to touch the ball in backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

5.) A-1 passes to A-2 who is standing under the opponent's basket when the ball touches the hand of A-2 and bounces up through the basket from below and comes to rest on the basket flange plate.

Official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

6.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw, B-2 in the second marked lane space quickly raises his/her arms, disconcerting A-1. While the ball is in flight toward the basket, A-2 steps into the lane. A-1's free throw fails to hit the rim.

Official rules this a double free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

7.) A-1 is awarded two free throws. While A-1 is in the act of shooting, B-1 enters the lane. A-1's free throw fails to hit the ring.

Official rules this a double free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

8.) Prior to A-1 releasing the ball on a free throw, B-1 is charged with a disconcerting act. A-1's free throw is successful but A-1 commits a free throw violation. Official cancels the free throw and awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

9.) A-1 has completed his/her dribble and then attempts a pass which hits an official and rebounds back to A-1.

Official rules this an illegal dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

10.) While the ball is in flight on a free throw by A-1, A-4 breaks the plane of the three point line before the ball hits the ring, backboard or the free throw ends.

Official rules this a free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

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11.) During A-1's dribble, the ball contacts B-1's hip causing A-1 to lose control. A-1 recovers the ball and begins another dribble.

The official rules this legal. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) Free thrower A-1 fakes the release of the ball. The fake does not cause any opponent to commit a violation.

The official charges A-1 with a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

13.) B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line and fouls thrower-in A-1.

Official rules this an intentional personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) As the ball comes through the net, A-1 gives the ball a tap. Official issues a warning to team A. Later in the game, team B has the ball out of bounds for a throw-in when A-2 breaks the plane of the boundary line.

Official assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) A-2 and A-3 set a screen for A-1. A-1 using the screen leaves the playing court. As soon as A-1 steps out of bounds the

official calls a violation on A-1. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) A-1 receives a pass while straddling the division line. A-1 then fumbles the ball which touches the floor in the frontcourt. A-1 instead of catching the ball begins a dribble off the fumble and dribbles back into the backcourt. Official rules this legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) As A-1 is dribbling from the backcourt to the frontcourt, A-1 has one foot touching in the frontcourt, while the other foot is in the air, when the ball hits the foot that is in the air and rebounds back into the backcourt. A-1 is the first to touch it in the backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) Prior to any warning for violating the plane of the boundary line, B-4 breaks the plane of the boundary line and fouls the thrower-in. Official rules an intentional personal foul on B-4 and issues a warning to team B. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-1 is dribbling in the backcourt and ends his/her dribble. A-1 is immediately double teamed and the defensive pressure prevents a pass to A-2. A-1 intentionally bounds the ball off one of the defensive players, recovers the ball and starts another dribble. The official rules it a double dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) On a throw-in by A-1 from his/her back court, the ball is passed toward the frontcourt when A-3 jumps from the frontcourt and while airborne bats the ball into the backcourt where A-2 catches it.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

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21.) During a designated spot throw-in, thrower-in A-1 passes the ball diagonally toward the boundary line. B-1, while the ball is on the out of bounds side of the boundary line, reaches through the boundary line and deflects the ball.

Official charges B- 1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) B-1, in order to avoid a screen near the boundary line, goes out of bounds.

Official rules B-1 is out of bounds for an unauthorized reason and calls a violation on B-1 when he/she stepped out of bounds. Is the official correct?

23.) A-1, while holding the ball, is straddling the division line. A-1 lifts the foot from the backcourt and then starts a dribble by bouncing the ball in the back court. When A-1 touches the ball, the official rules it a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) A-1's first free throw of a one and one is in flight when B-2 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows without contacting an opponent. A-1's free throw is unsuccessful.

Official awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) Following a field goal by team B, A-1's pass to a teammate, who is also out of bounds, is deflected by B-1 who breaks the plane of the boundary line.

Official assesses B-1 a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) During a throw-in, A-2 airborne from A's frontcourt, catches the ball. A-2 lands with one foot in the frontcourt and the other foot comes down nearly simultaneously in the backcourt.

Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) A-1's throw-in is caught by A-2 with one foot on the floor in the frontcourt. A-2 then steps into the backcourt with the other foot.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) A-2 from the backcourt, passes to A-3, who is straddling the division line. A-3 lifts the foot that is in the backcourt then puts it back down in the backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) While A-1 is dribbling past an opponent the ball touches the opponent without loss of control by A-1. A-1 catches the ball and starts another dribble.

Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) A-1, while holding the ball, is straddling the division line. A-1 lifts the foot that is in the backcourt then puts it back down in the backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

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31.) During a designated spot throw-in, A-1 places the ball on the floor and steps inbounds. Official immediately sounds the whistle and rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

32.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting the first of two free throws, B-1, in a marked lane space, fakes as if to enter the lane. A-1 releases the ball but it does not hit the rim. Official rules that the fake was not disconcerting to A-1. Official penalizes the fake only and awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) Team B is warned when B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line. Later in the game B-2 breaks the plane of the boundary line.

Official charges B-2 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

34.) During a dunk attempt by A-1, A-1 grasps the ring while the ball is directly above the basket to prevent being injured. After releasing his/her hands and before the ring returns to its original position, the ring contacts the ball.

Official rules this basket interference. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) A-1's throw-in goes directly out of bounds without touching a player inbounds. Official rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct? YES - NO

36.) A-2's throw-in is touched by A-5 in the backcourt but A-5 doesn't gain control. A-5 and no other players make any attempt to pick up the ball. Official starts the 10-second count. After 10 seconds, official rules this a 10-second backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

37.) A-1 passes to A-2. The pass is behind A-2 and A-2 cannot reach it. A-1 recovers the ball and dribbles. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) A-1's try rebounds off the backboard and is batted back toward the division line by A-2. A-3, while airborne from the frontcourt, catches the ball and lands in the backcourt.

Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) A-1, who has the ball in the frontcourt passes the ball toward A-2. B-2 bats the ball to the floor in A's frontcourt so it bounces toward the backcourt. A-1 runs into A's backcourt and catches the ball before it strikes the floor.

The official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

40.) While the ball is at the disposal of free thrower A-1, the official notices that A-2, in a marked lane space does not have one foot near the outer edge of the free throw lane line.

The official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

41.) B-1 commits basket interference on A-1's free throw. Official awards team A one point and charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
