- 1.) Thrower-in A-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line and shoves defender B-1 prior to releasing the ball. Official rules this a player control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 2.) A-1 secures a rebound and then throws the ball out in front of him/her. After the ball strikes the floor, A-1 recovers the ball and starts dribbling. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) A-1 is bleeding and the official stops play and directs A-1 to the bench. Team A has no 60-second time-outs remaining, but has one 30-second time-out. The coach wants to use the 30-second time-out to keep A-1 in the game. Official rules a 30-second time-out may not be used to keep A-1 in the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) While the ball is at the disposal of A-1 for a throw-in, A-2 is charged with a common foul. Team B is in the bonus. The official rules this a team control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) A-1, who is airborne, catches the ball in an attempt to save the ball from going out of bounds. Seeing that his/her momentum will carry him/her out of bounds, A-1 requests a time-out. Official denies the request. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) During an interrupted dribble by A-1, A-1, while chasing the ball inadvertently steps on the boundary line. When A-1 catches up with the ball and touches it, official sounds the whistle and rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 7.) Following a field goal, A-1 steps out of bounds with the ball. A-1 then places the ball on the floor, steps inbounds, pauses for a second, steps back out of bounds, picks the ball up and releases it within the time limit. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 8.) A-1, prior to dribbling, passes the ball to A-2. A-2 does not see the pass. A-1 runs across the court and recovers the ball with both hands after the ball has hit the floor. A-1 then begins a dribble. The official rules this an illegal dribble. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 9.) While the ball is in flight on a pass from A-1 to A-2, A-3 and B-3 commit a double personal foul. The official awards the ball back to Team A nearest to where A-1 was last in contact with the ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 10.) With 3 tenths of a second remaining in the fourth quarter Team A is awarded the ball out of bounds under its basket with Team B leading 50-49. Team A is not in the bonus. A-1 lobs a pass to A-2, who taps the ball toward his/her basket and is fouled before the signal sounds indicating time has expired. The tap is unsuccessful. The official rules B-1's foul is considered in the act of tapping and awards two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

- 11.) Following a violation by team A, the official is ready to administer the throw-in but team B is huddling and no player is available to receive the ball. Official places the ball on the floor and starts the 5-second count. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 12.) A-1 intercepts a pass with one foot on the floor. A-1 then throws the ball into the air, takes two full steps and bats the ball to a teammate. Official allows play to continue. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 13.) Official notifies the coach that A-1, who has just been disqualified, is no longer a team member. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 14.) Following a time-out, A-1 is to attempt a one and one, but delays entering the semi-circle when the official is ready to administer the free throw. The official uses the resumption of play procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 15.) During a jump ball to start the game, jumper A-1 taps the ball which is caught by A-2, who has one foot on the boundary line. Official rules this a violation, awards team B the ball and has the arrow set toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 16.) During an alternating possession throw-in by team A, B-1 fouls A-2. Team A is not in the bonus. Official awards the ball back to team A and instructs the scorer not to turn the arrow because this is not an alternating possession throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 17.) A-1 is erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds instead of receiving a one and one. Team A's throw-in is intercepted by B-1 but there after fumbled back to A-2. It is now recognized that team A was in the bonus. Official awards A-1 the one and one with players occupying the marked lane spaces and play will resume as with any normal free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 18.) Prior to A-1's free throw hitting the rim, backboard or the free throw ending, A-2, who is occupying a marked lane space, fakes entering the lane causing B-1 to step into the lane. Official penalizes the fake. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 19.) A-6, number 10, enters the game. Official notices that the number in front is red and the number in back is blue. Official rules that the shirt is illegal because the numbers must be the same color. Is the official correct? YES or No
- 20.) Team A has been in control of the ball for 7 seconds in the backcourt. A-1 throws a pass which hits the floor in A's frontcourt at 9 seconds. A-2 gains control at 11 seconds. The official rules this a 10 second violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 21.) A-1, while holding the ball and closely guarded in the frontcourt has the ball slip from his/her grasp with the officials count at two. A-1 recovers the ball. Official starts a new 5 second count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

- 22.) Following a time-out A-1 is in the semi-circle to attempt a one-and-one but two of his/her teammates are huddling in the lane as the official is ready to administer the free throws. Official issues a warning to team A. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 23.) Before A-1's free throw is released, A-2 fouls B-2 then A-3 steps into the lane. Official rules team A committed both a foul and a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 24.) With 3 tenths of a second on the game clock, play is resumed with a throw-in by A-1. A-1's throw-in is caught by A-2 who tries for a goal. Prior to the horn sounding, B-1 fouls A-2. A-2 releases the ball and time expires. The ball fails to enter the basket. Official awards A-2 two free throws for being fouled while in the act of shooting. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 25.) A-1, while airborne, intercepts a pass near the end line. Seeing he/she may land out of bounds, drops the ball to the floor. A-1 returns to the playing court, recovers the ball and begins a dribble. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 26.) A-1 and B-1 are the jumpers to start the game. A-1 taps the ball and B-1 catches it before the jump ball ends. Official rules this a violation, awards the ball to team A and sets the arrow toward team B's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 27.) A-1, while dribbling in the frontcourt, has the ball batted away. While the ball is loose, it is batted by B-2 toward A-2, who is near the division line. A-2 reaches out, is unable to control the ball, and bats the ball which hits the division line. A-2 then catches it. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 28.) A-1 is knocked to the floor and hits his/her head. The official determines that A-1 has been rendered unconscious during the first quarter. At halftime, the coach informs the referee that the appropriate health care professional has ruled that A-1 has recovered and will start the third quarter. The referee allows A-1 to return. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 29.) While A-1's try is in flight, B-1 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows. The try is successful. Official rules this a violation on B-1 and awards team A the ball out of bounds nearest the spot of the violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 30.) A-1 enters the game wearing an illegal jersey. The official fails to recognize it until A-1 has been playing for 4 minutes. The official stops play and charges the head coach with a direct technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 31.) A-1 lifts his/her pivot foot and then throws the ball toward A-2. A-2 does not see the thrown ball. After the ball hits the floor, A-1 is the first to touch the ball. Official rules this an illegal start of a dribble. Is the official correct? Yes OR no

32.) A-1 and B-1 jump at the center circle to start the game. A-1 taps the ball and B-1 catches the ball before the jump ball ends. Official awards the ball to team A and sets the arrow in the direction of A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) A-1 receives a pass from A-2. A-1 throws the ball out in front of him/her with reverse English, catches the ball and starts dribbling. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

34.) A-1 jumps into the air to attempt a shot. After the ball is clearly released, B-1 hits A-1's hand. The try is unsuccessful. Official regards the contact as incidental. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) On a throw-in by A-1 from his/her back court, the ball is passed toward the frontcourt when A-3 jumps from the frontcourt and while airborne bats the ball into the backcourt where A-2 catches it. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

36.) A-1 is erroneously awarded the ball out of bounds instead of the one and one. A-1's inbound pass goes to A-2, who is tied up by B-2 and a held ball is ruled. The possession arrow favors team A. The error is now recognized. Official awards A-1 the one and one with no players occupying the marked lane spaces and uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

37.) A-1 receives a pass while straddling the division line. A-1 then fumbles the ball which touches the floor in the frontcourt. A-1 instead of catching the ball begins a dribble off the fumble and dribbles back into the backcourt. Official rules this legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) During the intermission between the 1st and 2nd quarter, A-1 is assessed a technical foul and an indirect technical foul is charged to the head coach. The coach questions why he/she is also charged. The official informs the coach that during an intermission, team members are bench personnel. Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) A-1 is confused and attempts to score at the wrong basket. Prior to releasing the ball, A-1 is fouled by B-1. The ball enters the basket. The official counts the goal and awards A-1 a free throw for being fouled in the act of shooting. Is the official correct? YES or NO

40.) Jumper A-1's tap is simultaneously deflected out of bounds by A-2 and B-2. Official has the original jumpers re-jump to resume play. Is the official correct?

41.) During a throw-in by A-1, A-2 commits a common foul on B-2. Team B is in the bonus. Official resumes play by awarding team B a throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

42.) Player A-5 leaves the playing floor before his/her substitute is legally beckoned onto the court. While walking toward the bench, A-5 is assessed a technical foul and an indirect technical foul is charged to the head coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

43.) A-1 is between B-1 and B-2 on the restraining circle prior to the jump ball. As the official is ready to make the toss, A-1 backs straight off the circle. B-1 moves over next to B-2. Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

44.) As the official is bouncing the ball to thrower-in A-1, B-1 requests a time-out. Official denies the request, stating when he/she released the ball, the ball became live. Is the official correct? YES or NO

45.) Player A-1 ends his/her dribble then jumps into the air to shoot. While attempting to shoot, A-1 fumbles the ball. Prior to A-1 recovering the ball, it is touched by another player. A-1 recovers the ball while still in the air, returns to the floor and dribbles. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

46.) Both baskets in the gym have double rings. Official rules this is acceptable. Is the official correct? YES or NO

47.) As the official bounces the ball to A-1 for a throw-in and prior to A-1 catching the ball, B-2 fouls A-2. Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

48.) A-1 is fouled and awarded 2 free throws. As the official is ready to administer the first free throw to A-1, who is in the semicircle, and B-1 and B-2 are occupying the first marked lane spaces, B-3 and B-4 are huddling in the lane. Official issues a warning to team B for delaying the administration of the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

49.) A-1 receives a pass from A-2. A-1 passes the ball to a teammate but the ball hits an official. A-1 recovers the ball and starts a dribble. Official rules this a double dribble. Is the official correct? YES or No

50.) A-1 is fouled as the signal sounds indicating time has expired in the fourth quarter. Team B is leading 60 to 59. Team A is in the bonus. Before A-1 attempts the first free throw, Team B requests and is granted a time-out. The first free throw is administered and is successful. Following the attempt, Team B requests another time-out. The official grants the request ruling the ball became live between the two requests. Is the official correct? YES or NO

51.) Thrower-in A-1 shoves defensive player B-1 with the free arm and displaces him/her. Official rules this a player control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

52.) Team A has their team mascot on their wristband and headband. Official rules the school mascot logo is not permitted on these bands. Is the official correct? YES or NO

58.) Team A players are wearing memorial patches on the shoulder strap above the neckline. The patch has the player's number on it. Official rules the patch is illegal as worn. Is the official correct? YES or NO

59.) A-1 and B-1, in the low post, commit a double personal foul while A-2 is dribbling behind the semi-circle. Official awards the ball to team A nearest the spot of the foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

60.) Airborne shooter A-1 charges B-1. Prior to the foul, B-2 goaltends A-1's try. Official counts the basket and charges A-1 with a player control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

61.) Following a field goal and prior to the ball being at the disposal of team A, A-1 fouls B-1. Official rules this a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

62.) B-1 in the 2-point area, passes the ball toward the basket for a catch and dunk by B-2. A-1 leaps and touches the ball while it is on its downward flight, above the ring level, outside the cylinder and in the judgement of the official has a chance of entering the basket. Official rules goaltending and counts the basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

63.) A-1 is awarded one free throw. During the free throw, A-2 and B-2, who are occupying marked lane spaces, commit simultaneous lane violations. Official rules this a double free throw violation and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

Team B is properly occupying the required spaces, but A-1 is huddling with his/her teammates behind the semi-circle. Official applies the resuming play procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

65.) B-1 jumps from his/her frontcourt and intercepts A-1's throw-in pass. B-1 returns to the floor in the backcourt. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

66.) A-1 is fouled and awarded a one and one. Prior to A-1's first free throw, A-1 is assessed with a technical foul. A-1 attempts the first free throw which is successful. After 15 seconds, it is determined the arrow is pointing in the right direction. A-6, A-7, B-6 and B-7 fouls are offsetting and awards no free throws, charges two indirect technical fouls to coach of team B, 3 team fouls to team B, 4 team fouls to team A, ejects all players and the coach of team A, and awards team B two free throws plus the ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO

83.) B-1 commits his/her fifth foul. B-6 replaces B-1. Following the warning horn, A-6 reports to enter the game. Official denies A-6 from entering the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

84.) A-1 is in the act of shooting when B-2 fouls A-2. A-1 continues the motion and scores. The official disallows the basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

85.) A-1, from behind the 3 point line, throws the ball toward his/her basket for a catch and dunk. The ball is on its downward flight outside the cylinder above the ring level and in the judgment of the official has a chance of entering the basket when A-2 catches the ball and dunks it.
