

laabo Rule # 6 2011 - 2012

- 1.) During an alternating possession procedure, thrower-in A-1 places the ball over the boundary line. B-1 is able to get his/her hands on the ball and it is ruled a held ball. Official awards the ball to team B stating that when the ball was touched inbounds the arrow changed. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 2.) Airborne shooter's try lodges between the rim and backboard. Official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) While airborne shooter A-1's try is in flight, the signal sounds indicating time has expired in the quarter. Prior to A-1 returning to the floor, B-1 fouls A-1. Official charges B-1 with a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) While A-1's pass is in the air to A-2, B-1 deflects the pass. Official inadvertently sounds the whistle and grants a time-out requested by team A's coach. Official rules the time-out cannot be denied or revoked and after the time-out has expired, uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) During an interrupted dribble, the official inadvertently blows the whistle. The official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) During an alternating possession throw-in, A-1's throw-in is intentionally kicked. The official awards the ball to team A and rules that it is not an alternating possession throw-in and team A retains the possession arrow. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 7.) A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw when B-2 fouls A-2 along the lane. Official cancels the free throw, charges the foul and re-administers the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 8.) Official mistakenly gives the ball to team A for a throw-in following a held ball. After the ball is touched inbounds the mistake is recognized. Official rules the mistake cannot be corrected but team B will get the ball on the next alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 9.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw and prior to releasing the ball, a double foul is assessed. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official cancels the free throw and re-administers the free throw with no players occupying the marked lane spaces and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 10.) A-1's throw-in under the alternating possession procedure is caught simultaneously by A-2 and B-2 causing a held ball. The official awards the ball to Team B. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) Time expires in the 4th quarter with the score tied and the possession arrow favoring team A. The official begins the overtime period with a throw-in by the team entitled to the ball under the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) Jumper A-1 catches the ball after the ball has been tapped, but before the jump ball has ended. Official rules this a violation, awards team B the ball and sets the arrow toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

13.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting the first free throw of a one and one, B-1 steps into the lane. Official inadvertently sounds the whistle. A-1 continues the motion. The ball enters the basket. Official counts the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) Space between A-2 and B-2 on the restraining circle prior to the jump ball is vacant. When the official makes the toss, but before the ball is tapped, A-1 moves laterally into the space next to B-2. Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) B-1 fouls A-1 while B-2 is in the act of shooting. B-2 continues the throwing motion and scores. Official penalizes the foul and counts the basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) While in the act of shooting and prior to releasing the ball, A-1 is fouled after the signal sounds indicating time has expired in the quarter. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official disallows the basket and awards no free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) While A-1's try is in flight, a double personal foul is charged. Ball enters basket. Possession arrow favors team A. Official charges the foul, counts the goal, awards team B the ball and rules team B may move along the end line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) A-1's 2nd free throw hits the ring and comes to rest on the flange. Since the ball is motionless, the official sounds the whistle. The free throws were the result of A-1 being fouled by B-1 on an unsuccessful try. The official rules this a free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-1, while in the act of shooting and prior to releasing the ball, is fouled after time expires. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official disallows the basket but penalizes the foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) During an alternating possession throw-in by A-1, A-1 places the ball through the plane of the boundary line. B-1 grabs the ball resulting in a held ball. Official awards the ball back to team A and rules this is an alternating possession throwin. Is the official correct? YES or NO

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21.) With three-tenths of a second remaining in the game, A-1's throw-in is caught by A-2, who is fouled as he/she throws the ball toward his/her basket. The foul occurs before the signal sounds indicating time has expired. Team A is in the bonus. The official awards A-1 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) During an alternating possession procedure throw-in, the official awards the ball to team A instead of team B. Team A commits a throw-in violation before the ball is touched inbounds. The mistake is recognized at this point. The official awards the ball to team B and rules this is still an alternating possession procedure throwin. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) Following a jump ball, the tapped ball is touched simultaneously by A-2 and B-2 and deflected out of bounds before either team gains control. Official re-jumps with the original jumpers. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) During an alternating possession throw-in by A-1, A-1 commits a throw-in violation. The official awards the ball to Team B and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow toward Team B's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) A-1 and B-1 jump to start the game. A-1 touches the ball and B-1 catches it before the jump ball has ended. Official awards the ball to team A and sets the arrows toward team A's basket. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) Following a violation with six-tenths of a second on the game clock in the fourth quarter, thrower-in A-1 throws the ball from mid-court and hits the backboard. Official inadvertently sounds the whistle. Possession arrow favors team B. Official re-administers the throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) After the referee tosses the ball for a jump ball and before the ball is tapped, A-2 moves into an unoccupied space. Official rules this a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) A live ball lodges in the basket support and ruled a held ball. The possession arrow favors team A. While A-1 has possession for the throw-in, A-2 and B-2 commit a double personal foul. Official gives the ball back to team A and instructs the scorer to turn the arrow when the throw-in is touched. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) While A-1's second free throw of a one and one is in flight, B-1 fouls A-2 and then A-3 steps into the lane before the ball hits the rim, backboard or the free throw ends. Ball enters basket. Official disallows the free throw and charges B-1 with a personal foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw, B-1 fouls A-2 along the line. Official blows the whistle. A-1 continues the motion and scores. Official cancels the free throw, charges the foul and re-administers the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
