

Iaabo Rule # 7 2011 - 2012

- 1.) While A-1's try is in flight, A-2 and B-2 commit a double personal foul. The try is unsuccessful. Official charges the fouls and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES OR NO
- 2.) While A-1's try is in flight, A-2 fouls B-2. The ball enters the basket. Team B is not in the bonus. The official rules Team B's throw-in is a designated spot throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) Following a field goal, A-1 passes to a teammate who is out of bounds on the end line. The ball hits the official who is out of bounds. The ball bounces off the official and goes directly onto the court and is recovered by A-3 who scores. Official disallows the basket and rules this a violation for an illegal throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) Team A commits a violation and immediately is granted a time-out. Following the timeout the official mistakenly awards team A the ball for the throw-in. As A-2 is dribbling up court the official recognizes the mistake and blows the whistle. Official takes the ball back to the original throw-in spot, awards the ball to team B and puts the consumed time back on the game clock. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) While A-1's second free throw of two is in flight, the official assesses a double personal foul. The ball enters the basket. The official counts the free throw and resumes play by awarding team B a throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) After the horn sounds ending the half, A-1 and B-1 are charged with a double technical foul. Official charges the foul and resumes play to start the second half using the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 7.) Following a violation by team A, team B is huddling and doesn't make a player available for the throw-in. Official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or No
- 8.) A-1's throw-in is caught by B-2, while touching the boundary line. The official rules a throw-in violation and awards the ball to Team B at the spot of the throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 9.) Following a score by Team A and while the ball is at the disposal of Team B, A-1 commits an intentional personal foul on B-2 near the end line. The official awards B-2 two free throws, awards the ball back to Team B and rules Team B still has the privilege of the moving along the end line. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 10.) While A-1 has the ball out of bounds under the alternating possession procedure, A-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line with the ball. B-1 grabs the ball causing a held ball. Official gives the ball back to team A for an alternating possession throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

- 11.) While A–1 is dribbling, A–2 commits a common foul on B–2. Team B is in the bonus. Official awards B–2 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or No
- 12.) Following a score, A–1 has the ball out of bounds for the throw-in when B–1 breaks the plane of the boundary line. Official issues a warning to team B. Official rules team A no longer has the privilege of moving along the end line. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 13.) Following a time-out, A-1, who is to attempt a one-and-one, is not in the semi-circle as the official is ready to administer the free throw. Official assesses A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 14.) While A–1’s try is in flight, A–2 and B–2 are charged with a double personal foul. The try is successful. Official charges the fouls and uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 15.) Following a field goal by team A, B-1 has the ball for the throw-in. B-1 runs and jumps through the plane of the boundary line. B-1 releases the ball when he/she is three feet beyond the boundary line and over the court. Official rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 16.) Thrower-in A–1 passes the ball to A–2. A–2 taps the ball back toward A–1, who has one foot touching the floor inbounds and the other foot in the air over the boundary line. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 17.) While A-5 is holding the ball, B–1 fouls A–1 near the division line and at the same time A–2 fouls B–2 near team B’s end line. Official rules simultaneous personal fouls. The possession arrow favors team A. Official awards no free throws, uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play and awards team A the ball nearest team B’s foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 18.) Team A is entitled to a throw-in under the alternating possession procedure. Official erroneously awards team B the throw-in. The mistake is recognized while the ball is at the disposal of team B. Official rules the mistake was recognized within the timeframe and awards the ball to team A. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 19.) As A–1 is holding the ball near the sideline next to the bench area, the coach grabs A–1’s arm to get his/her attention. Official rules that A–1 is out of bounds. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 20.) While A-1 is dribbling above the semi-circle, A-2 and B-2 in the low post are assessed with a double personal foul. Official awards the ball back to team A nearest to where the ball was located. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) A–1, who is the thrower-in from a designated spot, fumbles the ball which rolls several feet away along the end line. A–1 leaves the designated spot, retrieves the ball, returns to the designated spot and releases the ball before the count reaches 5 seconds. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct YES or NO

22.) During a throw-in, A-1 passes the ball over the rectangular backboard to A-2 for a dunk. The official rules that throwing the ball over the rectangular backboard on a throw-in is legal. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) During an alternating possession procedure throw-in, A–1 releases the ball. Before the ball is touched inbounds, B–2 fouls A–2. Team A is not in the bonus. Official awards the ball back to team A and rules this is still an alternating possession procedure throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) Following a violation, thrower-in A-1 jumps into the air and forward toward the boundary line. A-1 's body has crossed the plane of the boundary line but still has one foot over the designated spot prior to releasing the ball. Official rules this a legal throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) B–1 fouls A–1 while in the act of shooting. Ball enters basket. It is B–1's fifth foul. B–6 reports and is beckoned into the game. B–6 joins his/her teammates, who are huddling with their coach. Official instructs team B to break the huddle but the coach continues to huddle. Official administers the free throw to A–1. The try is successful. Following the free throw, and team B still huddling, the official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) Following a score by team A and while the ball is at the disposal of B-1, A-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line. The official issues a warning to team A, awards the ball to team B and rules team B retains the privilege of moving along the end line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) Following a score by team B, A–1's throw-in pass is deflected out of bounds over the endline. Official awards the ball back to team A and rules team A may run the endline. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) Following a player control foul on A-1, the official has reported the foul and ready to administer the throw-in but team B is huddling and no player is available to take the ball. Official assesses team B with a technical foul for delaying the game. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) While A-1 is dribbling, A-2 commits a personal foul on B-2. Team B is in the bonus. Official awards B-2 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO
