

Iaabo Rule # 9 2011 – 2012

- 1.) A-1, while dribbling in the frontcourt near the division line, has the ball deflected away by B-1 and caught by A-2 who is straddling the division line. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 2.) A-1 is in the lane in possession of the ball for 2 seconds when A-1 starts to dribble toward the basket. Official suspends the count. A-1 stops and fakes several times. Official sounds the whistle and rules a 3-second violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) A-1 from the backcourt throws a pass to A-2, who is in the frontcourt. The ball is overthrown and hits the backboard and rebounds into the backcourt. A-1 is the first to touch the ball. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) Thrower-in A-1 rolls the ball up the floor in backcourt. As soon as the ball touches the floor in backcourt the official starts the 10 second violation count. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) Prior to any warning for violating the plane of the boundary line, B-4 breaks the plane of the boundary line and fouls the thrower-in. Official rules an intentional personal foul on B-4 and issues a warning to team B. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) Team A scores. During the throw-in, A-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line and is issued a warning. Official awards the ball back to team B and rules team B's throw-in will be from a designated spot. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 7.) While A-1's try is in flight, B-1 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows. The try is successful. Official rules this a violation on B-1 and awards team A the ball out of bounds nearest the spot of the violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 8.) Team B, was issued a warning for interfering with the ball following a score. Later in the game, B-1 breaks the plane of the boundary line on a throw-in and fouls A-1. Official charges team B a technical foul for delaying the game and charges B-1 with an intentional personal foul for fouling A-1. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 9.) A-1's try for goal is in flight when B-2 excessively swings his/her arms and elbows without contact. Official charges B-2 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 10.) A-1 is straddling the division line and dribbling when a teammate, who is running along side A-1, has one foot in the frontcourt and the other in the air over the division line when the ball touches him/her and rebounds into the backcourt. A-1 is the first to touch the ball. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) B-1 secures a rebound on A-1's missed shot and throws a pass toward the division line. A-2 near the division line leaps from his/her frontcourt, catches the ball and lands with the left foot in frontcourt and the other foot comes down in the backcourt. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) While A-1 has control in the backcourt, A-1 passes the ball into the frontcourt where it hits an official and rebounds into the backcourt without the ball touching the floor and then is touched by A-1. The official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

13.) A-1's throw-in is touched by A-2 in the frontcourt and goes directly into the backcourt. A-1 retrieves the ball in the backcourt. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) A-1 is awarded two free throws. While A-1 is in the act of shooting, B-1 enters the lane. A-1's free throw fails to hit the ring. Official rules this a double free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) A-1, while straddling the division line, fumbles the ball. The ball then lands in the frontcourt. A-1 recovers the ball while still straddling the line. Official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) A-1 receives the ball while straddling the division line. A-1 lifts the foot that is in the backcourt, then starts a dribble which hits the division line. When A-1 touches the ball after coming back up from the floor, the official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) A-1's throw-in is deflected by B-1. A-2, while airborne from his/her frontcourt, catches the ball and lands in the backcourt. Official rules it a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) Team B is warned when B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line. Later in the game B-2 breaks the plane of the boundary line. Official charges B-2 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-1, who has the ball in the frontcourt passes the ball toward A-2. B-2 bats the ball to the floor in A's frontcourt so it bounces toward the backcourt. A-1 runs into A's backcourt and catches the ball before it strikes the floor. The official rules this a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) Following a field goal by team B, B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line and deflects a pass from A-1 to A-2 on the end line. Official charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

- 21.) A-1 has the ball to attempt the first of two free throws. Before A-1 releases the ball, B-1 steps into the lane and the official gives the appropriate signal. A-1 sees the official give the signal, is confused, and tosses the ball to the official. Official blows the whistle and readministers the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 22.) During an interrupted dribble by A-1, a 3-second violation is called on team A by the lead official. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 23.) A-1 is preparing to attempt the first of two free throws. B-1, who is occupying a marked lane space, fakes as if to enter the lane. A-1 releases the ball, but it does not strike the ring. Disconcertion is not involved. Official rules this a double violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 24.) Team A is awarded an alternating possession throw-in. A-1's throw-in pass is illegally kicked by B-2. The official rules a kicking violation. The official instructs the scorer to change the arrow to Team B and then awards the ball to Team A for a throw-in nearest to where the kicking violation occurred. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 25.) A-1 passes to A-2. A-2's pass to A-3, hits an official and rebounds back to A-2. A-2 then starts a dribble. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 26.) As A-1 is dribbling past an opponent, the ball touches the opponent. A-1 is still able to give the ball direction in a controlled manner but instead of continuing to dribble, catches the ball. A-1 then starts a new dribble. The official rules it a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 27.) A-1 passes to A-2 who is standing under the opponent's basket when the ball touches the hand of A-2 and bounces up through the basket from below and comes to rest on the basket flange plate. Official uses the alternating possession procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 28.) A-1, releases the ball on a throw-in. Defender B-1 steps along side of A-2, reaches over the out of bounds side of the boundary line and catches the ball depriving A-2 the opportunity of receiving the ball. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 29.) While A-1's free throw is in flight, B-1 in a marked lane space, commits a lane violation, followed by A-2 stepping into the lane. A-1's try is unsuccessful. Official penalizes only B-1 and awards A-1 a substitute free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 30.) During a designated spot throw-in by A-1, A-1 fumbles the ball which rolls several feet away. A-1 leaves the designated spot and retrieves the ball, returns to the designated spot and releases the ball before the count reaches 5 seconds. Official rules this a legal play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

31.) During a designated spot throw-in, thrower-in A-1 passes the ball diagonally toward the boundary line. B-1, while the ball is on the out of bounds side of the boundary line, reaches through the boundary line and deflects the ball. Team B has received no prior warnings. Official charges B- 1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

32.) While A-1 is in the act of shooting a free throw, B-2 in the second marked lane space quickly raises his/her arms, disconcerting A-1. While the ball is in flight toward the basket, A-2 steps into the lane. A-1's free throw fails to hit the rim. Official rules this a double free throw violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) After securing a rebound, A-1, attempting to prevent a held ball or loss of control, moves his/her arms and elbows back and forth as a result of body movement. Official rules this a violation for excessively swinging arms and elbows. Is the official correct? YES or NO

34.) A-1's throw-in is touched by B-1, who is standing on the boundary line. Official rules this a violation on B- 1 and awards the ball to team A near the spot where B-1 touched the ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) A-1, who is dribbling from the backcourt to the frontcourt, has both feet in the frontcourt while dribbling in the backcourt. Official continues the 10 second count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

36.) B-1 reaches through the plane of the boundary line and slaps the ball out of thrower-in A-1's hands. Official charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

37.) During a designated spot throw-in, A-1 places the ball on the floor and steps inbounds. Official immediately sounds the whistle and rules this a throw-in violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) A-1 is holding the ball and closely guarded by B-1 (B-1 is within 6 feet of A-1) but A-2 is standing between A-1 and B-1. Official starts the 5-second closely guarded violation count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) A-1, closely guarded in the frontcourt starts a drive directly toward the basket. A-1 gets his/her head and shoulders in advance of the defender. Official ends the 5 second closely guarded count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

40.) The referee, to start the game, permits the teams to go in the wrong direction. Jumper A-1 back taps the ball to A-2. As A-2 dribbles across the division line, official sounds the whistle and rules a backcourt violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

41.) Thrower-in A-1 is the first to touch the ball near the division line. Official rules this a throw-in violation and awards team B the ball nearest the spot of the touching. Is the official correct? YES or NO
