

Iaabo Rule# 10 Practice Quiz 2010 – 2011 (page 1)

- 1.) A–1, who is legally out of bounds, deceitfully delays his/her return to the playing court. Official charges A–1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 2.) –1, who is legally out of bounds, deceitfully delays his/her return to the playing court. Official charges A–1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) A–6 and A–7 leave the team bench and enter the playing court when it appears a fight may occur. Official charges both with flagrant technical fouls and one indirect technical foul to the coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) B–1 is guarding A–1 the thrower-in. A–1 places the ball through the boundary line and shoves B–1 in the chest with the ball while still holding it and displaces B–1. Official rules this an unsportsmanlike technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) B-1 fouls A-1 and is awarded a one and one. The administering official has given all instructions and signals. Team B is properly occupying the required spaces, but A-1 is huddling with his/her teammates behind the semi-circle. Official applies the resuming play procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) At the beginning of the third quarter, team A takes an excessive time-out. The scorer fails to notify the official. After the third quarter ends, the scorer informs the official that team A's last time-out was an excessive timeout.

The officials rules an excessive time-out must be recognized within the correctable error time frame to penalize. Is the official correct? YES or NO

7.) Number 15 of team A reports to the scorer and is beckoned into the game. After No. 15 is beckoned into the game, the scorer discovers there is no No. 15 in the scorebook. The scorer adds the name and number, but fails to notify the official of the addition. At the first dead ball, the scorer informs the official he/she added the name and number to the scorebook. Official assesses a technical foul to team A. Is the official correct? YES or NO

8.) A–1 and B–1 begin to fight while the ball is dead. A–6 and A–7 enter the playing court. B–6 also enters the playing court and begins fighting with A–6.

Official charges A–1, B–1, A–6, A–7 and B–6 with flagrant technical fouls, team A coach with two indirect technical fouls, coach B with one indirect technical foul, team A with three team fouls, team B with two team fouls and awards team B two free throws plus a throw-in at the division line opposite the scorer's table. Is the official correct? YES or NO

9.) B–1 is discovered participating after he/she has been disqualified. The official charges a direct technical foul to the head coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

10.) A-1 and B-1 begin to fight during a dead ball. The head coach of team A, who was not beckoned onto the court, rushes onto the court. The official charges A-1 and B-1 with a flagrant technical foul and banishes them to the bench, charges the coach with a flagrant technical foul and banishes him/her from the vicinity of the bench, awards team A no free throws and 2 team fouls, awards team B two free throws and 1 team foul, followed by a division line throw-in. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) B-1, who previously had been disqualified, is participating in the game when discovered. Official charges B-1 with a flagrant technical foul and an indirect technical foul to the coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) A-1 places a hand on the ring to push his/her self around to the other side of the basket to grab a rebound. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct?

13.) Following A-1's throw-in, A-1 purposely delays his/her return to the playing court. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) Team A is leading Team B by 5 points with 2 seconds remaining in the game. Airborne player B-1 is attempting a 3 point try and is fouled by A-1. B-1 releases the ball and prior to airborne shooter B-1 returning to the floor, A-2 is charged with a blocking foul on B-1 as time expires.

The official rules this a false multiple foul, awards B-1 three free throws for each foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) A held ball is ruled between A-1 and B-1. A-1, while getting up, shoves B-1. B-1 picks up the ball and throws it at A-1.

Official assesses each player with a technical foul, awards each team two free throws and resumes play by awarding the ball to team A at the division line opposite the table and rules it has no effect on the possession arrow. Is the official correct? YES or NO

16.) B-1, while guarding A-2, who does not have the ball, waves his/her hands in A-2's face trying to obstruct A-2's vision from receiving a pass from A-1.

Official charges B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) The coach of Team A is signaling for a time-out both visually and orally but is not able to get either official's attention. The coach goes to the scorer's table and has the timer sound the horn. The official stops play to confer with the coach, who informs them he/she has been trying to get a time-out.

The official charges the coach with technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) After reporting the foul, the official is ready to administer A-1 his/her free throw but A-1 is not in the semicircle.

Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-1 is fouled and awarded a one and one. As the official is ready to administer A-1's free throw, A-1 is not positioned in the semi-circle. Official places the ball on the floor and starts the 10 second count. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) Thrower-in A-1 completes the throw-in to A-2. A-1 fails to immediately enter the playing court after releasing the ball.

Official rules A-1 has committed a violation. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) Team A's head coach fails to replace or remove a disqualified player or a player directed to leave the game within 20 seconds. The official rules a direct technical foul be charged to the head coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) A-6 enters the game wearing an illegal number. The official does not recognize it until the ball becomes live. Official assesses A-6 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) Team A scores. After the ball passes through the net, A-1 purposely grabs the ball and steps out of bounds and passes to A-2, who scores.

The official stops play, charges Team A with a technical foul, disallows the basket and puts the consumed time back on the game clock. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) Team A enters the court wearing illegal jerseys. The official charges the coach with a direct technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) The lead official bounces the ball to A-1 for a one-and-one. B-1 in a marked lane space steps into the lane and taps the ball away.

Official assesses B-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) During halftime, one of the starting players on Team A uses profanity towards an official.

The official charges the player with a direct technical foul and charges the head coach of Team A with an indirect technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) Team A's coach and bench personnel are all standing within the confines of the designated bench area yelling encouragement for A-1 during a free throw.

Official charges team A with one technical foul and also charges the coach with an indirect technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) A-1 is fouled and awarded 2 free throws. Following the first free throw, A-2 delays the administration of the second free throw by hand slapping free thrower A-1.

Official issues a warning to team A for delaying the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) As the official is ready to place the ball at A-1's disposal for the throw-in, he/she notices team A has six players on the floor.

Official assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) After the signal sounded indicating time had expired in the first half, A-1 removes his/her jersey within the visual confines of the playing area. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul and an indirect technical foul to the coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

31.) After reporting the foul the official is ready to administer A-1 a one-and-one but team B is huddling with the coach. Official sounds the whistle and pauses for a moment, but team B continues huddling.

Official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

32.) A-1 enters the game wearing an illegal jersey. The official fails to recognize it until A-1 has been playing for 4 minutes. The official stops play and charges the head coach with a direct technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) After the ball goes out-of-bounds, A-1 and B-1 begin to fight and are charged with a double flagrant foul. A-6 and B-6 come onto the floor at the same time. A-6 does not participate in the fight but B-6 becomes involved in the fight.

Official charges A-6 and B-6 with flagrant technical fouls, charges each coach with one indirect technical foul, two team fouls to each team, awards no free throws and resumes play with an alternating possession throw-in at the point of interruption. Is the official correct? YES or NO

34.) Coach of team A is charged with an indirect technical foul. Official informs the scorer that the foul counts as a team foul to reach the bonus. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) A-10 enters the game in the first quarter and plays several minutes and then is replaced. A-10 does not score or commit any fouls. Prior to starting the second quarter, the scorer informs the referee that A-10's name and number are not listed in the official scorebook.

Referee instructs the scorer to add A-10's name and number to the squad list and assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

36.) As the referee is checking the books at the 10-minute mark, he/she notices that A-6 and A-7 are wearing identical numbers. The referee rules no penalty can be assessed until they become players. Is the referee correct? YES or NO

37.) B-1 reports to the scorer for entry and the scorer notices that B-1 is wearing a different number than listed in the scorer's book. While B-1 is waiting to enter the scorer notifies both the coach and official. Prior to B-1 becoming a player, the coach has B-1 return to the bench.

Official instructs the scorer to change the number in the book and charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) There is nothing wrong with A-1's jersey, but the coach has A-1 change his/her shirt and number at halftime. A-1 reports the change to the scorer and official. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) A-1 commits an illegal screen on B-1 and is charged with a common foul. It is team A's seventh foul. The official awards B-1 a one and one. Is the official correct? YES or NO

40.) Following a field goal by A-1, A-2 purposely grabs the ball as it comes through the basket and inbounds the ball to A-3. A-3 then has it stolen by B-2. At this point the referee recognizes team A had an unauthorized throw-in. Official stops play, charges team A with a technical foul and puts the consumed time back on the game clock. Is the official correct? YES or NO
