

laabo_Rule 10 2011 – 2012

- 1.) A-10 enters the game in the first quarter and plays several minutes and then is replaced. A-10 does not score or commit any fouls. Prior to starting the second quarter, the scorer informs the referee that A-10's name and number are not listed in the official scorebook. Referee instructs the scorer to add A-10's name and number to the squad list and assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 2.) It appears a fight may break out and A-6 and A-7 enter the playing court. The official charges A-6 and A-7 with flagrant technical fouls, charges team A's coach with one indirect technical foul, charges team A with two team fouls to reach the bonus, awards team B two free throws and resumes play by awarding the ball to team B at the division line. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 3.) As the official bounces the ball to free thrower A-1, B-1, in a marked lane space, steps into the lane and deflects the ball away. Official issues a warning to team B. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 4.) A-1 is fouled and awarded 2 free throws. Following the first free throw, A-2 delays the administration of the second free throw by hand slapping free thrower A-1. Official issues a warning to team A for delaying the free throw. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 5.) Following A-1's throw-in, A-1 purposely delays his/her return to the playing court. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 6.) After reporting the foul the official is ready to administer A-1 a one-and-one but team B is huddling with the coach. Official sounds the whistle and pauses for a moment, but team B continues huddling. Official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 7.) Following a goal by A-1, A-2 purposely grabs the ball and inbounds it to A-3. Play continues until B-1 is called for a common foul. The mistake is now recognized. Official charges team A with a technical foul, cancels the common foul and puts the consumed time back on the clock. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 8.) With 3 tenths of a second remaining in the fourth quarter Team A is awarded the ball out of bounds under its basket with Team B leading 50-49. Team A is not in the bonus. A-1 lobs a pass to A-2, who taps the ball toward his/her basket and is fouled before the signal sounds indicating time has expired. The tap is unsuccessful. The official rules B-1's foul is considered in the act of tapping and awards two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO
- 9.) A-1, who was disqualified, is discovered participating in the game. Official charges A-1 with a flagrant technical foul and an indirect technical foul to the head coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

10.) Dribbler A-1, while dribbling, sees that he/she is about to be overtaken by B-1. A-1 cuts across B-1's path so quickly that B-1 cannot avoid the contact. Official rules this a player control foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

11.) Number 45 reports to the scorer's table during a time-out and enters the court following the time-out. Team A has not been assessed an administrative technical foul after the 10-minute mark. After the ball becomes live, the scorer informs the official there is no No. 45 in the book. Official has the scorer place No. 45's name and number in the book and charges team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

12.) As the referee is checking the books at the 10-minute mark, he/she notices that A-6 and A-7 are wearing identical numbers. The referee rules no penalty can be assessed until they become players. Is the referee correct? YES or NO

13.) Ten minutes before the game the referee goes to the scorer's table to check the books. As the referee is checking the books he/she discovers that team A starters have 0 and 00 in the book. Official notifies the coach that one of the players will have to change his/her number and when this is done, assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

14.) As the official is ready to place the ball at A-1's disposal for the throw-in, he/she notices team A has six players on the floor. Official assesses team A with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

15.) A-1 and B-1 get into a confrontation, which is handled by the officials without penalty. A-6 and A-7 leave the bench and enter the court. Referee charges A-6 and A-7 with flagrant technical fouls, one indirect technical foul charged to the coach, two team fouls which count to reach the bonus and awards team B two free throws, plus the ball. Is the Referee correct? YES or NO

16.) After the signal sounded indicating time had expired in the first half, A-1 removes his/her jersey within the visual confines of the playing area. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul and an indirect technical foul to the coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

17.) A-1 and B-1 begin fighting while the ball is live. A-6, A-7, B-6 and B-7 enter the court followed by the coach of team A, who was not beckoned. B-6, B-7 participates in the fight. A-6, A-7 do not. Official rules no free throws will be attempted for A-1's and B-1's fouls. A-6, A-7, B-6 and B-7 fouls are offsetting and awards no free throws, charges two indirect technical fouls to coach of team B, 3 team fouls to team B, 4 team fouls to team A, ejects all players and the coach of team A, and awards team B two free throws plus the ball. Is the official correct? YES or NO

18.) Team A's head coach fails to replace or remove a disqualified player or a player directed to leave the game within 20 seconds. The official rules a direct technical foul be charged to the head coach. Is the official correct? YES or NO

19.) A-5 changes his/her shirt and number at halftime and reports the change to the scorer and official. Official rules that no penalty will be assessed. Is the official correct? YES or NO

20.) While A-2 is dribbling, A-1 and B-1 begin to fight. Substitute A-6 and B-6 enter the court. A-6 does not participate in the fight but B-6 does. Official disqualifies A-1, B-1, A-6 and B-6, awards no free throws, charges each coach an indirect technical foul, each team with two team fouls and resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

21.) A-1, who was disqualified in the third quarter, reports to the scorer's table and is beckoned into the game. Prior to the ball becoming live, it is recognized A-1 was not eligible to play. Official assesses no penalty and directs A-1 to the bench. Is the official correct? YES or NO

22.) B-1 fouls A-1. It is the 7th foul of the half. As the official is ready to administer the free throw, A-1 is huddling with his/her coach and does not enter the semi-circle. The official uses the resumption of play procedure to resume play. Is the official correct? YES or NO

23.) A-1, who is legally out of bounds, deceitfully delays his/her return to the playing court. Official charges A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

24.) The coach of Team A is signaling for a time-out both visually and orally but is not able to get either official's attention. The coach goes to the scorer's table and has the timer sound the horn. The official stops play to confer with the coach, who informs them he/she has been trying to get a time-out. The official charges the coach with technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

25.) A-1 attempts a dunk and then grabs the ring to prevent being injured. While the ball is outside the cylinder, A-1, continuing to grasp the ring, secures the ball. Official assesses A-1 with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

26.) A-6 and A-7 leave the bench and enter the playing court because a fight has broken out between A-1 and B-1. A-6 and A-7 participate in the fight. No other bench personnel for either team enter the court. B-1, A-1, A-6 and A-7 are charged with flagrant technical fouls. Two indirect technical fouls are charged to Team A's head coach, three team fouls are charged to Team A and one team foul is charged to Team B. Team B is awarded four free throws and the ball at the division line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

27.) A–1 scores. A–2 purposely grabs the ball, steps out of bounds and passes to A–3, who scores. While the ball is at the disposal of team B, the throw-in by A–2 is questioned. Official charges team A with a technical foul, cancels the score and puts the consumed time back on the clock. Is the official correct? YES or NO

28.) Following a time-out by team A, team B is still huddling with its coach on the out of bounds side of the boundary line when the official sounds the whistle to resume play. Team A responds. Four players of team B enter the court, but one player continues to delay out of bounds with his/her coach. Official resumes play with the alternating possession procedure. Is the official correct? YES or NO

29.) A–1 fouls B–1. As officials are walking to the free throw line, B–2 is charged with a dead ball contact foul. After all the free throws, official awards team A the ball out of bounds at the division line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

30.) A-1 and B-1 get into a confrontation which is handled by the officials without penalty. A-6 and A-7 leave the bench and come on the floor. Official charges one team foul to team A, one indirect technical foul to the coach, and awards team B two free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

31.) held ball is ruled between A–1 and B–1. A–1, while getting up, shoves B–1. B–1 picks up the ball and throws it at A–1. Official assesses each player with a technical foul, awards each team two free throws and resumes play by awarding the ball to team A at the division line opposite the table and rules it has no effect on the possession arrow. Is the official correct? YES or NO

32.) B-1 reports to the scorer's table to enter the game. It is then discovered B-1 is wearing a different number than listed in the official scorebook. Prior to B-1 entering the game, the scorer notifies the coach and official. The coach has B-1 return to the bench. Official charges team B with a technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

33.) During halftime, one of the starting players on Team A uses profanity towards an official. The official charges the player with a direct technical foul and charges the head coach of Team A with an indirect technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

34.) Number 15 of team A reports to the scorer and is beckoned into the game. After No. 15 is beckoned into the game, the scorer discovers there is no No. 15 in the scorebook. The scorer adds the name and number, but fails to notify the official of the addition. At the first dead ball, the scorer informs the official he/she added the name and number to the scorebook. Official assesses a technical foul to team A. Is the official correct? YES or NO

35.) Team A is granted an excessive time-out but the scorer fails to notify the official. While A-1 is holding the ball out of bounds for the throw-in, the scorer recognizes the mistake and sounds the horn informing the official that team A's time-out was an excessive time-out. Official rules that the time frame to penalize has expired. Is the official correct? YES or NO

36.) Team A's coach and bench personnel are all standing within the confines of the designated bench area yelling encouragement for A-1 during a free throw. Official charges team A with one technical foul and also charges the coach with an indirect technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

37.) The AD of team A, who is sitting on the bench, is assessed a technical foul. As the official is reporting the foul, player A-1 and a member of the bench objects to the technical foul and each is assessed a technical foul. Official charges the coach with two indirect technical fouls, charges three team fouls to reach the bonus, awards team B six free throws and awards team B the ball out of bounds at the division line. Is the official correct? YES or NO

38.) At the beginning of the third quarter, team A takes an excessive time-out. The scorer fails to notify the official. After the third quarter ends, the scorer informs the official that team A's last time-out was an excessive timeout. The officials rules an excessive time-out must be recognized within the correctable error time frame to penalize. Is the official correct? YES or NO

39.) Airborne shooter A-1 fouls B-1. The ball lodges between the rim and backboard. The possession arrow favors team A. Official awards team B the ball out of bounds. Is the official correct? YES or NO

40.) B-1 is guarding A-1 the thrower-in. A-1 places the ball through the boundary line and shoves B-1 in the chest with the ball while still holding it and displaces B-1. Official rules this an unsportsmanlike technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

41.) Coach of team A is charged with a direct technical foul. Later in the game an indirect technical foul is assessed to the coach. Official ejects the coach for receiving his/her second technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO

42.) While the ball is in flight on a throw-in by A-1, A-2 commits a common foul on B-2. Team B is in the bonus. The official rules it a team control foul and awards no free throws. Is the official correct? YES or NO

43.) A-1 enters the game wearing an illegal jersey. The official fails to recognize it until A-1 has been playing for 4 minutes. The official stops play and charges the head coach with a direct technical foul. Is the official correct? YES or NO
